Dear Patients,

We have been informed that the Pharmacy that provides the methadone we distribute is doing a voluntary recall on all bottles that were distributed between March of 2015 and June of 2016. We have been provided with a list of lot numbers and have identified patients who were served Methadone from these bottles. According to the pharmacy, the purified water that they use to make this product was at risk of being exposed to a potentially harmful bacterium. We have been assured that all Methadone undergoes stringent testing before it is sealed and sent to us, and zero bacteria was detected in any of the bottles where there was a reason for concern. In addition, no illnesses have been reported by anyone consuming the medication, to date.

There is nothing that you need to do as these bottles have long since been ingested and can no longer be returned. This letter is simply a formality to inform you that this recall is taking place and that it has been thoroughly investigated.
